CONDITIONS OF FAIR PLAY:

- 1) I will teach my players to play fairly and to respect the rules, officials and opponents.
- 2) I will ensure that all players get equal instruction, support and playing time.
- 3) I will not ridicule or yell at my players for making mistakes or for performing poorly. I will remember that players play to have fun and must be encouraged to have confidence in themselves.
- 4) I will make sure that equipment and facilities are safe.
- 5) I will remember that participants need a coach they can respect. I will be generous with praise and set a good example.
- 6) I will obtain proper training and continue to upgrade my coaching skills.
- 7) I will work in cooperation with officials for the benefit of the game.

RWHL - PLAYER CONDITIONS:

- 1) No coach/staff shall be verbally abusive to any referee or member of the Association.
- 2) No coach/staff shall abuse any referee or any other member of the Association.
- 3) All OWHA, Hockey Canada, and RWHL Constitution and By-Law's are to be abided by.

- 2) Coaches/Staff will assign player positions keeping in mind what position the player requested and will establish their team's line-up in a fashion that is in the best interest of the team.
- 3) Coaches/Staff will ensure to the best of their ability, that all players receive equal ice time in accordance with By Law C-2 of the RWHL Constitution.
- 4) Coaches/Staff will ensure that the game sheet is completed in advance of the game and provided to the timekeeper. Coaches should monitor weekly game sheet to ensure that suspended players are aware of their suspensions and comply appropriately.
- 5) Coaches/Staff will familiarize themselves with the rules of hockey, particularly as they pertain to the RWHL.
- 6) Coaches/Staff will encourage players to adhere to the principles of fair play and sportsmanship at all times
